School seminar explores the impact of screen time and how to keep children safe online

Managing the impact of screen time – and the imperative of keeping children safe online – has become a major concern for parents everywhere and is the subject of a special seminar hosted by Winnipeg Mennonite Elementary and Middle Schools (WMEMS).
